(GEOLOGICAL MAPPING EXERCISE)

Explore the landscape using the **arrow** keys or **WASD** keys to control movement.

At your disposal is a GPS Handset (**G**) and Compass (**C**) to help you navigate.

Click on the **notebooks** to see more information or the **camera** for a photograph; you need to be close to the notebook or camera for interaction.

Record the data in pencil onto the field map - you will need to interpret as you go.

Just as in the field, you need to plan your route between outcrops to accurately complete the map

INSTRUCTIONS

Arrow Keys or **WASD** keys - to control movement

Mouse - to control head (where you are looking at)

Space Bar - Jump

G - Toggle GPS on / off

C - Toggle Compass on / off

Click on notebooks or cameras when nearby to get field data and photographs.

Esc – to be able to move mouse cursor out of window, e.g. to go to other programs or to close the landscape
